

Discipline: (8) Masse
Shot / Challenge #: 2
Degree of Difficulty: 8

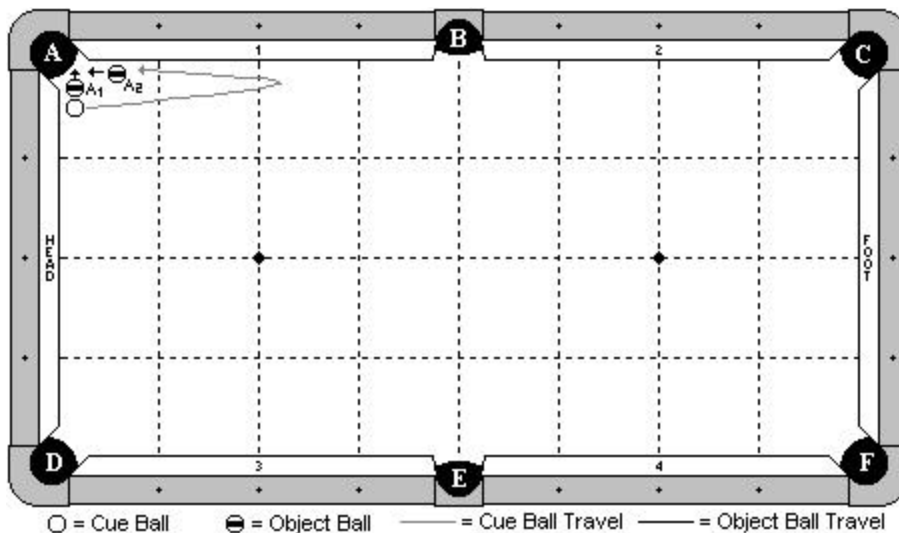
Cue Ball Placement: In hand.

Object Ball(s) Placement: 'A₁' ball is approximately 1/8" from cue ball. 'A₂' ball is 2 ball's width away from slate cut of pocket 'A' and 1/2 off cushion # 1.

Objective: Shoot cue ball with vertical masse into 'A₁' ball and toward cushion # 1 to the right of 'A₂' ball. Cue ball contacts cushion # 1, and then comes back toward 'A₂' ball. 'A₁' ball makes at pocket 'A' first, then 'A₂' ball makes in same pocket.

Special Notes: Cue ball does not have to contact cushion # 1. Cue ball may make 'A₂' directly. Contact with foot cushion is not allowed. Scratch is allowed (no penalty). Extra cushion # 1 contacts by cue ball, or cushion # 2 contacts by cue ball, are allowed. This shot can be done from any corner of the table, but it may not be rotated. In other words, 'A₂' ball must be positioned along either cushion # 1, 2, 3, or 4. It may not be positioned along the head or foot cushion.

Scoring Potential: 1st attempt – 8 points
2nd attempt – 7 points
3rd attempt – 6 points
